Access Statement for Longstone Cottage, Self Catering Holiday Home

Pre-Arrival

- This website contains photographs and comprehensive information about the cottage and the local area
- · No pets including assistance dogs are allowed in any area of the property
- Booking/enquiries can be made via the website contact form, booking form, email or telephone
- The nearest railway station is Berwick upon Tweed, 14 miles north of the hamlet
- The nearest bus stops are Smeafield Lodge on the A1, 1.6 miles and Middleton Cottages on North bank, 1.4 miles
- The nearest airport is Newcastle International Airport, 48 miles
- · Grocery deliveries can be arranged with several of the major supermarket chains

Arrival and Car Parking

- There is off road parking through a gate for one car on a paved and grassed area to the side of the cottage
- Access to the front door (700mm wide) is via 4 steps from the parking area or level access over grass through the front gate from the road along a concrete path
- Small step and raised threshold through the front door into a small porch area narrowest point 760mm
- Automatic outside light

Ground Floor

Lounge

- Level access through a door from the porch (all internal doors are 700-720mm wide)
- The floor is carpeted, and has a rug in front of the multi fuel stove
- Overhead lighting can be turned on or off at either end of the room (all overhead light switches at 1420mm)
- Smart TV with subtitle facility
- Amazon Echo
- · Multi fuel stove with guard and raised hearth, heat resistant glove and tools provided
- · Electric radiator thermostat set on wall at height of 1380mm

Kitchen

- · Level access to the kitchen through a door, passing the stairs to the first floor
- Tiled flooring
- · Ceiling lights can be turned on or off at either end of the room
- Table height 750mm access to table on 3 sides, narrowest being 1000mm
- Bench height 920mm
- Thermostat on shelf at height of 1620mm
- Fire extinguisher on wall at height of 1600mm

Bathroom

- · Level access through a door from the kitchen
- Tiled flooring
- Ceiling light
- P bath with shower and shower screen bath height 610mm and length 1690mm
- Anti-slip mat provided
- Wall hung sink, height 840mm
- Floor space width 600mm

Toilet

- · The only toilet in the cottage is on the ground floor
- · Level access from the kitchen, through 2 doors, passing the step to the conservatory
- · Carpet tiles on the floor
- 700mm from toilet basin to the closed toilet door
- No hand washing facility in the toilet there is a wash hand basin in the adjacent bathroom

Conservatory

- · Access via one step (190mm) through 800mm doorway no door
- Tiled floor
- · Glazing to British Standards

Stairs and Landing

• 10 carpeted steps to a landing, then a 90 degree turn to the right, up 3 more steps to the first floor landing

First Floor

Bedroom 1

- · Level access through a door from the landing
- Kingsize bed with synthetic duvet and pillows
- Carpeted floor
- · Bedside tables with table lamps at each side of bed
- Space around bed 500mm 1100mm
- Bed height 600mm
- Central light
- · Blackout blind at window

Bedroom 2

- Level access through a door from the landing
- · 3 single beds with synthetic duvets and pillows
- Carpeted floor
- Bedside tables with table lamps beside each bed
- · Central space with access to all beds 1000mm
- Bed height 500mm
- Central light
- Blackout blind at window

Gardens

- Enclosed gardens to front and rear there is no gate between the steps to/from the car park area and the front garden
- Access to the concreted patio and paved terrace area at the rear of the cottage is through the conservatory patio door and down 3 steps or level access through a side gate along a concrete path from the parking area
- Access to the gently downward sloping grassed area is down 2 steps from the patio area and 1 step from the terrace
- · The terrace is walled with iron railings on the field side
